

Dear Supervisor Oliverio,

I am writing on behalf of the Putnam County Fire Advisory Board (FAB). Enclosed please find a copy of the final draft of the Putnam County Fire & EMS Mutual Aid Plan. The plan outlines the process for requesting, receiving and providing mutual aid assistance to neighboring departments and communities. This plan has been developed over the last two years by the Fire Advisory Board with the assistance and support of the Bureau of Emergency Services staff. FAB membership includes representatives appointed by the Chiefs of each of the County's fire and ambulance agencies. The Mutual Aid Plan was unanimously approved by the Board at its May 15, 2017 meeting.

Adoption of this plan is a multi-step process which includes securing a resolution from each department and municipality in the County. It is then adopted by the Board of Legislators and finally approved by the New York State Office of Fire Prevention and Control. Copies of this plan have been forwarded to each agency and municipality for review and adoption.

I respectfully request that you work with your Town Board to review the plan and pass a resolution formally adopting it. I have enclosed a sample resolution for your reference. Once adopted, please forward a copy of the resolution to my office for our records. Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions concerning this important public safety document.
