Workshops for Actors to be Offered at Tompkins Corners

This fall, Tompkins Corners Cultural Center will offer Theatre Workshops for Actors on Monday evenings at 7:30, beginning on Monday, September 24th.

Judy Allen, actor, director and theatre teacher, whose credits include off-Broadway, regional theatre and a five-year residency at La MaMa ETC, will lead the workshops, which will focus on scene study, monologues and possibly songs as well.

"I studied and worked with great teachers and directors, and I want to pass on some of the skills I've learned," said Ms. Allen. "Actors are always seeking to hone and improve their craft. And whether you are a professional or community theatre actor, it's always possible to find something new to inspire your work and make you better."

Hudson Valley playwrights will also be invited to bring in their work for actors to read, so they can hear how it sounds to a live audience in a workshop setting.
