Re: CLEAN-FLO Proposal – Lake Peekskill

Dear Sam,

In response to your request, we submit this proposal to continue our maintenance, treatment, and testing services at Lake Peekskill. This proposal is for 3 years which includes 2021 through 2023.

## Maintenance

On-going maintenance is a key ingredient for any mechanical system. We will provide maintenance services for the oxygenation system. Maintenance will include changing filters and oil in the compressor, ensuring proper operation, changing variable drive settings if needed, adjusting diffuser boils, cleaning diffusers, moving diffusers as needed due to depth changes from sediment reduction, and monitoring changes in the conditions of the lake.

Maintenance visits will be conducted at least 4 times per year. Any system repairs or replacement parts needed during the 3-year term outside of the normal maintenance scope of activity would be an additional cost.

# Performance monitoring

Testing will continue to measure dissolved oxygen, total phosphorus, soluble reactive phosphorus, organic sediment content, sediment phosphorus and algal community assessment. Samples will be taken from 4 locations, 4 times per year except for algal community, which will be 3 locations 4 times per year. All samples will be analyzed by an independent laboratory except the dissolved oxygen which will be taken with our YSI.

A yearly report will be prepared which will include all the sample results.

# Biological augmentation program

Biological augmentation will continue to be performed to reduce organic sediments on the bottom of the lake, reduce overall nutrient levels in the water column and shift the algal

community to diatoms. Diatoms are a simple form of algae that do not color the water green and have a tremendous beneficial value to the ecosystem. They are a source of food for fish, which other nuisance forms of algae are not. They consume nutrients and by being part of the food chain for fish, help reduce nutrient levels.

Our biological augmentation plan includes 3 applications each year. Our yearly applications will include our CFLO+, Clean & Clear enzymes, and Bio Booster. These products are all natural and non-toxic.

# Sonar Scan

In the fall of each year, we will perform a sonar scan of the lake and prepare updated contour maps. All mapping will be included in the year-end report.

## Cost

The cost for the activities outlined for 3 years will be \$65,430. This cost does not include any non-scheduled visits required by the Town, or the cost of any system repairs or replacement parts needed during the 3-year term outside of the normal maintenance scope of activity.

We look forward to working with the Town of Putnam Valley to continue improving Peekskill Lake. Please feel free to call us with any questions.
