

## Floating Object Application Checklist

A complete application for a revocable permit to place a floating object in navigable waters of the State must include, but is not limited to, the following checked items:

A completed Application for Floating Object Permit bearing your original signature.

A location map showing the general location of the project site in relation to identifiable roads and landmarks;

An accurate section of chart or scale drawing of the waterway showing the position of the floating object and other existing structures such as docks, buildings, roads, other permanent structures and landowners with approximate property boundaries;

An accurate drawing of the proposed floating object (please refer to enclosed “typical” depictions) or a picture of the actual floating object(s) to be placed. Please include dimensions, structural materials, colors, lighting method (if applicable) and anchoring method;

Color photographs of the area where the floating objects are proposed to be located;

For DEC jurisdiction: Completed Part 1 of the Short Environmental Assessment Form. This form can be accessed at <http://www.dec.ny.gov/permits/6191.html>;

Include a complete and signed Letter of No Objection from Local Marine Law Enforcement (attached to application)

Include written permission of the upland owner, if other than the applicant. One (1) copy of all required items must be submitted in order to process your application. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact this office. After initial review of your submittal, you may be requested to supply additional information.
