Supervisor Annabi asked for a moment of silence to honor our troops stationed at home and around the world. We also remember those we lost in our County, Ed Scott and William Keating.

PRELIMINARY 2024 BUDGET DISCUSSION AND REVIEW

Presented by Supervisor Annabi

Supervisor Annabi said after some additional changes the budget has been reduced to 1.68%. This includes all the work we are doing, the loan we received, the Union Contracts, the unfunded mandates, this is well below the tax cap. This is a great number. Councilman Luongo asked if any money was taken out of the Fund Balance. Supervisor Annabi said that \$500,000,00 was taken out. Supervisor Annabi said we will leave Public Comment open until next week, and we will vote on the budget in November.

DISCUSS DRAFT REGULATIONS FOR LOCAL LAW RELATING TO SHORT TERM TRANSIENT RENTALS (STR'S)

Presented by Supervisor Annabi

Attorney Ryan said the only things that were red lined on this one (1) is some of the definitions and typos. Supervisor Annabi said she thought we were going to add something about the fencing/screening. Attorney Ryan said she did not as of yet; but she will amend it for next week. It will read the screening/fencing will be required at the discretion of the Planning Board in their review. Attorney Ryan said the Board should also create a different fee for these applications which has to be done by Resolution.

Supervisor Annabi asked with the addition of the screening would we have to have another Public Hearing. Would we have to start all over again? Attorney Ryan said you would not have to start all over again because the Public Hearing remains open. Attorney Ryan will draft a new Resolution reintroducing it, and then the Board would likely vote on it in November. Supervisor Annabi said we are planning to vote on the short term rentals on November 15th. We could always leave it open again if need be.

DISCUSS AMENDING TOWN CODE ON MOORING REGISTRATION IN ALL SPECIAL DISTRICTS; SET PUBLIC HEARING

Presented by Supervisor Annabi

Supervisor Annabi said we currently have a Mooring Law on the books but there was a "loophole" and the new law will amend this to close this "vagueness". This will repeal and replace the original Mooring Code. Attorney Ryan said now you must show a cable or electric bill and a current tax bill in order to get a mooring. Supervisor Annabi would like to change that to just an electric bill instead of making a cable bill a choice because not everybody uses cable. Attorney Ryan will make that change.

WHEREAS, the amendments require a Public Hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Town Board hereby sets a Public Hearing on the proposed amendments for November 15, 2023 at 6:00 PM, or as soon thereafter as the matter may come to be heard, in the Town Hall, 265 Oscawana Lake Road, Putnam Valley, NY; and
- 2. The Town Board directs the Town Clerk to notify the Town Clerks of each of the surrounding Municipalities of the Public Hearing pursuant to GML §239-nn.
