Boat America This one-day 8-hour class meets NYS Requirements for Boati Safety Certificate (ages 10 and up) and Personal Watercraft (PWG) Operator (ages 14 and up)

NYS Law: <u>All individuals</u> are required to hold an approved boater safety certificate to operate a motorboat beginning in 2025. PWC: Must be at least 14 years old and hold an approved boater safety certificate or be accompanied by someone over 18 years old that holds an approved boater safety certificate.

NYS Brianna's Law - Applies to all powerboat operators: • Those born on or after 1/1/1983 <u>currently</u> need a sufety certificate • Those born on or after 1/1/1978 need a sufety certificate beginning January 2024 All motorboat operators regardless of age will need a boating safety certificate beginning January 1. 2025.
